“A failure in any course will require summer school” (Trinity Catholic handbook, p 16). There are many options available, both public and private, to fulfill the course requirement. Course dates and registration approach quickly, so please make an effort to register as soon as possible. Please be sure to have the final summer school transcript sent to Trinity Catholic so that we may appropriately credit your transcript and promote the student. If you are seeking to take summer school outside a local public school district or one of the listed private school options, approval is needed from Trinity Catholic to ensure the credits would be acceptable. Please contact Mr. Kmack to discuss any alternative option.

Most summer programs begin shortly after the conclusion of the academic year. REGISTER EARLY!
